### The Lady with the Lamp

Florence Nightingale founder of modern nursing was born May 12,1820 in Florence Italy. She came from a wealthy family. She did what is unexpected of a young affluent woman in her time. She turned down a marriage proposal from a man with means and pursued nursing despite her parents refusal. She became well known for her compassionate care and for improving sanitation during the Crimean War (1853-1856). She was referred to by the wounded soldiers as "the lady with the lamp" and "the Angel of Crimea".
